

Legends of Kalidasia: Dryden Heavy Destroyer Assembly Instructions

- One 3D Printed Dryden Hull
- Four 3D Printed Missile Batteries
- One 3D Printed Flight Stand

Assembly Instructions

Be sure to use proper safety equipment when assembling these figures such as safety goggles and a mask designed for resin sanding. Required tools include clippers, a file and cyanoacrylate glue. 3D printed miniatures require several assembly steps before painting.

Step 1 – Remove Support Material



Using clippers and a file, remove the remaining 3D printed support material from the miniature. The above image shows some examples of support material highlighted in red. Your miniature will be a bit different. After removing this material, the little bumps where support material was attached to the miniature will need to be filed down.

Step 2 – Free Missile Launchers



The Missile launchers have support material which needs to be removed with clippers.

Step 3 – Attach Missile Launchers

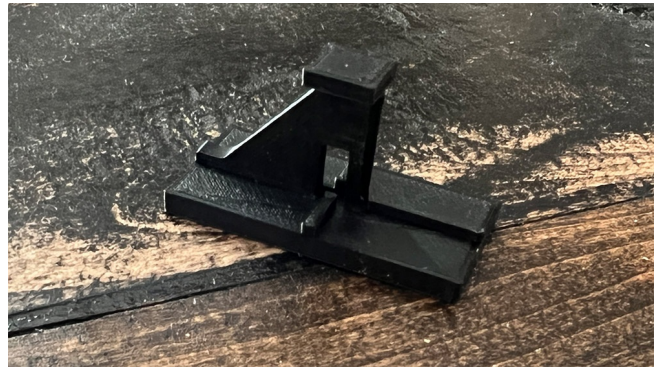


Attach each of the launchers in the shown locations. The face of the launcher with the six holes is the front of the launcher and they can face any direction.

Assembling the Flight Stand

The included flight stand contains three parts – a Base, a Riser, and a Topper. It is assembled as shown below. The empty channel in the riser is placed over the center of the base. Please note that the back of the riser may not align with the back of the base. The image below shows a frigate class stand.

Magnets can be used to attached the warship to the stand if desired. This would also allow for the warship to spin around the base, which can be helpful for tracking certain aspects of the game.
